Minutes from April meeting approved with the correction that Kern Smith was not in attendance at that meeting.

Parks: David Eisenbacher will remove the dead trees at Lakeside Commons when he can find the time. Bill will email Jim McCauley to find out if/which areas were reseeded. The fallen tree behind Mrs. Baker's house was removed. The wood chips were placed at the swing set on Forest Commons.

Two other trees in Forest Commons need to be removed. One is totally dead and the other is infected with the emerald ash borer. Bids to remove will be obtained after assessing the rest of Forest Commons for tree removal.

COTHA: Bill Jenuwine will be receiving a Troy Volunteers Award on May 14th.

Treasurer: Kern reported on liens and went over the treasurers report.

Other business: A homeowner is concerned about the unsightliness of the yard behind 1640 Crimson (on Crestline). The Board suggested that Mike Bean could draft a letter to the homeowner on Crestline asking them to clean up their yard. The Board also recommended contacting the building department for possible code violations.
